If any student disregards this rule, the remainder of your trip will be canceled and your parents will be called to make arrangements for you to return to Deer Trail by the next available means at the expense of your parents.
3. In the event of a disagreement, the decision of the sponsor(s) is final. They are in charge of the trip and the responsibility for decisions rests with them.
4. In the event illness should occur, the sponsor(s) will make every effort to contact the parent. The student's medical insurance and health information will be given to the sponsor(s) before the group leaves on the trip.
5. If you choose to not follow the expectations stated above, you will not be allowed to participate in future school sponsored trips.
