President Mike Geesen called the meeting to order at 1:01 PM. All the BOE members were present-Christel McNeil by electronic device. Also in attendance: BJ Buchmann, Nanci Sweet and Hayley Whitehead in person. Phillip Donovan, Seandra Humbert, Tyler and Robin by electronic device.

MOTION: Candice Reed made the motion to approve the Agenda. Wesley Thompson seconded the motion. Cowell, aye; Geesen, aye; McNeil, aye; Reed, aye; Thompson, aye. Motion carried.

This meeting was to give information to the BOE about what is happening and what will be happening in the next bit of time.

SUPERINTENDENT REPORT

Mr. Buchmann gave an explanation of the Audio/Visual package that is being installed in the gym and in the auditorium. There will be an additional camera placed in the gym and a camera placed in the auditorium. The sound system will be placed in the gym.

FFA Complex was the next topic. He explained where we were with the permit. Next discussion will be deciding where to tap into the water.

Track surfacing. The supplies for the track are being dropped off. As soon as the weather holds to the correct temperature, the red surfacing will be applied to the track. The track needs to have some leveling done to it before that surface is applied.

Gym floor was addressed when the representative from Ponder came out. The gentleman was very nice and answered many questions. Candice Reed was present and had lots of questions. She had walked the gym floor and put markers out showing where she had concerns. The man stands behind his floor. We need to put more coats of sealant on the floor and should be good to go.

Linnebur has been in the building putting in shelving and hanging bulletin boards.

Signs need to be installed telling people to not be on the track after surfacing has been put down. In addition, we might want to put signs up saying do dogs on the playground are.

Budget Conversation was held. The budget for the current year should be good. The governor is believing that there might be some issues that will impact the 2020-2021 budget.

Seandra Humbert described how the teaching is being handled with the distance learning. She said we are not distance teaching, we are crisis teaching. Paper packets have been

sent home for the students who do not have internet or that were requested by parents. Teachers are using class dojo. The school can send out information on school dojo. Google Classroom is being utilized. Teachers can shut down a chrome book if the student is not using the chrome book in an appropriate manner. She said there are many programs out there that teachers and parents can utilize. She showed the board Commonsense.com and it is programs on Wide Open School. Chrome books agreements were handed out for every chrome book sent home.

Assignments will be returned to the school on Mondays. New assignment packets will be sent out on Monday afternoons.

Mr. Buchmann said that he would like to start interviewing teachers in the near future. It was agreed that someone from the FFA Advisory group would be part of the interviewing committee for the FFA teacher.

There is a CSB/CDE meeting at 3:00 PM today.
