President Mike Geesen called the meeting to order at 6:03 PM. All board members were present. Also in attendance were BJ Buchmann, Nanci Sweet, Hayley Whitehead, Ben Coleman (FP), Matt Menning (CS), Kevin Huber (CS) and Steve Vetter.

Matt Menning and Kevin Huber went over the schedule of what will be happening, what we have money set aside for and what we may have left.

Roughly \$90,000 in contingency. \$25,000 pending changes.

Holding \$30,000 for the IREA Disconnect of the old school. \$35,000 for reseeding. \$44,000 for demo and abatement

There is still concern about not having the sound system. We are not comfortable with the quote that we have received. We are hoping to find a more economical sound system.

Ben Coleman said that we should get the final Certificate of Occupancy next week. There are 20-25 punch list items. Those should be done by the first of the year. Mike Geesen asked if we were going to get a deep clean of the school. Ben said that it is not how it is done. It cost \$30,000 to do a deep clean. They have cleaned the building once. The workers have been cleaning up when they work in an area. He said the he was not able to say that they would do another cleaning.

Mike Geesen said that he wanted a written agreement on what they would be paying if we have to go across the street to play football next year.
